

KJESTER CITY COUNCILS SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES
FRIDAY JUNE 25, 2010 @ 1:30 P.M.
KJESTER CITY HALL

The Kjester City Council held a special meeting on Friday, June 25, 2010 @ 1:30 p.m. in the council chambers. Members present were Mayor Oldfather, Council Members Don Jensen, Marcus Elvebak, Ted Mattick, and Jack Moon. Members from the public in attendance were Brandon Hagenson, Fire Chief, and Norm from KBEW.

Mayor Oldfather called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. Mayor Oldfather read the resolution declaring a State of Emergency within the City of Kjester. Moon made a motion that was seconded by Jensen approving said resolution. Roll Call vote- All voted in favor of approving the state of emergency resolution.

Mayor Oldfather read the Presidential Declaration resolution requesting the City of Kjester to be declared a disaster. Jensen made a motion that was seconded by Mattick approving said resolution. Roll Call vote- All voted in favor of approving the Presidential disaster declaration resolution.

Brandon Hagenson, Fire Chief requested permission to put ads in surrounding area newspapers to thank the communities for helping with the clean-up following the tornado. Hagenson will take care of the ads. He also indicated that the department will be taking part in area parades in the cities that helped during the tornado. Elvebak made a motion that was seconded by Jensen approving his requests. Carried 5-0. Jacobson will send a letters to SDS crews, and County Commissioners.

Mayor Oldfather shared information from Robin Thompson (Region 9), providing assistance to the elderly filling out forms or help getting disaster assistance. The Salvation Army served 100 breakfasts Friday morning, and 435 dinners at noon. Norm from KBEW was soliciting storm information from the council.

Elvebak made a motion that was seconded by Jensen to adjourn the meeting. Carried 5-0.
